- 2000 - Discovery and insertion of the mission area in the tribal belt of Maramangalam, Yercaud.
- 2001- Humble beginning of the community center and the community school with 7 students.
- 2003 - Recognition of the school by the Government of Tamil Nadu upto std. V - Elevated as high school in the year 2004 and upgraded as higher secondary in 2007. The first batch of students appear for +2 exam.
- After 20 years of struggle and perseverance, today the school has a strength of 854 tribal students with 234 boarders and 60 committed teaching and non-teaching staff members. Coupled with good academic and curricular activities, our tribal students are performing exceptionally well in sports and games. We have already produced four National athletes. The NCC, NSS, Scouts and Guides along with Bulbuls and Cubs have brought accolades to the school.
- Our intervention is slowly and steadily bearing much fruits. A society that has been isolated and sidelined is waking up to join the mainstream of life with hope and enthusiasm. We are ever grateful to our Benefactors, Brothers of the Province, the Govt. of Tamil Nadu and all our well-wishers and friends.


